

### **Overview**

OneCamp is a new event concept for Scouts WA, bringing together everyone from Joey Scouts to Rover Scouts to participate in adventurous, fun, challenging and inclusive activities linked to Milestones, Outdoor Adventure Skills and Special Interest Areas.

#### **Theme**

Western Australia is the best place on the planet to see the total solar eclipse in April 2023! Just as the sun, moon and earth align, OneCamp 2023 – Eclipse will unite our age sections as we share out-of-this-world Scout adventures.

#### When

The OneCamp 2023 core event will run from Tuesday 11 April 2023 till Wednesday 19 April 2023. Age sections attend OneCamp 2023 for different durations to reflect progress along their Scouting journey. Optional Expeditions for Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts of varying length will run from Friday 7 April till Thursday 13 April.

#### Location

OneCamp 2023 will be hosted at the Swan Valley Adventure Centre. Expeditions and offsite activities will be held across Western Australia.

## **Program**

OneCamp 2023 participants will experience everything Scouting has to offer across a variety of program elements.

<b>Challenge Zones</b> : onsite activities focused on Challenge Areas of Outdoor, Personal Growth, Creative or Community.					
Outdoor Adventure Skills Zone: onsite adventure-based activities with experienced participants leading less experienced participants.					
<b>Special Interest Area Zone</b> : onsite activity zones focused on STEM, innovation, sport, arts, literature, environment, and creating a better world.					
<b>Adventure</b> : one offsite day with a specific focus such as abseiling, boating, personal development, bushcraft, or creative arts.					
<b>Mini Expedition</b> : overnight offsite experience with a specific focus such as cycling, photography, cooking, target sports, or snorkelling.					
<b>Expedition</b> : multi-day offsite experience with a specific focus such as kayaking, sailing, bushwalking, leadership, or pioneering.					
<b>Entertainment</b> : evening activities including live music, silent discos, chill zones, outdoor movies, finale party and magic shows.					
<b>One Program Day</b> : everyone onsite for market day, district showcases, and a big night of evening entertainment! Open to visitors.

## How to apply

Applications for OneCamp 2023 are completed using our Online Event Application System. All applicants must apply individually – there is no option to register members of your Unit in bulk for OneCamp 2023. You can apply via our website: <a href="https://www.onecamp.com.au">www.onecamp.com.au</a>.

Applications will close in December 2022.

For your application to be considered complete, the first payment as per the payment schedule must be paid via our Online Event Application System before applications close.

#### **Waiver forms**

Some activities may require participants to have a completed waiver form signed by their parent or guardian. Should a participant (or their parent/guardian) choose not to complete the activity, a substitute activity will be arranged. No refunds will be provided. Waiver forms are to be uploaded to our Online Event Application System.





### **Event fees**

The different fees for each age section are detailed below. Event fees for Scouts, Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts have been spread across two payments.

<sup>\*</sup>Expedition costs for Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts are additional and depend on the expedition chosen. Expeditions are optional – Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts can attend the core event without attending an expedition if they choose. The payment schedule for expeditions will be advised once expeditions are announced later in 2022.

#### **Fee inclusions**

The event fee includes:

- event program, including all activities and evening entertainment.
- all accommodation costs.
- transport to and from offsite activities.
- transport to and from the event, including travel to and from Swan Valley for regional participants.
- all meals for the duration of OneCamp 2023.
- a merchandise pack including a badge, shirt, and hat.

Expeditions for Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts will attract an additional fee, determined by the expedition chosen by the participant.
