TRANSPORT

- Transport will be provided to and from OneCamp 2023 for WA participants.
- Interstate participants will be collected from the airport.
- Transport information will be loaded into the online event management system.
- Coaches will be equipped with luggage compartments for personal luggage bags. Participants and supporting adults need to **pack their luggage into a single bag** for ease of travel on the coach to and from the event.

TRANSPORT

- Flight and coach captains will be appointed for each transport, responsible for:
 - Checking attendance using flight/coach manifest provided.
 - Ensuring medication is collected and passed to the appropriate Assistant Line Leader – Health & Wellbeing upon arrival at OneCamp.
 - Contacting the Event Operations Centre should any issues arise.

ONSITE PARKING

- Where ever possible, please travel on the transport provided.
- For adults travelling independently to OneCamp, there will be two parking locations:
 - Long term parking for overnight volunteers
 - Short term parking for day volunteers.
- Follow the instructions of the Traffic & Security Team when you arrive onsite.

TOILET & SHOWER FACILITIES

- A mixture of permanent and temporary facilities will be available.
- Toilets will be located within each Village.
- Some dormitory buildings will be used to provide youth toilets and showers. These facilities will be clearly signposted.
- Dormitory buildings accommodating event staff will also be used by adults camping in Units for showers.
- Facilities will be labelling on the site map.

EQUIPMENT COLLECTION DAY

- Equipment collection day is Thursday 20 April between 9:00am and 12:00pm.
- Organise for a parent/guardian not attending to collect the trailer.



EQUIPMENT LOANS

- The type of equipment available for loan includes:
 - Dining shelters
 - Sleeping tents
 - Limited supplies of cooking equipment e.g. eskies/tables.
- Equipment will be delivered to your campsite.
- Email your equipment request to onecamp@scoutswa.com.au by **Sunday 18 March 2023**.
- If you would loan a dining shelter and would like it erected before OneCamp starts, send a representative of your Unit on either Saturday 8 April or Monday 10 April to show us where to locate the shelter on your campsite, and to help erect shelters.

CAMPSITES

- In some areas the ground is very hard – consider some extra tools to get tent pegs in (and out!).
- Campsite sizes are based on allowances made at Australian Jamborees – 15 square metres per person. Campsites have been mapped to match the size of your OneCamp Unit.
- Campsites will be pegged and labelled – please stay within your boundaries.
