# CATERING TIPS FOR UNITS

- Ensure that all youth and adult members bring along a reusable lunch container that fits into their daypack.
- A meal guide booklet with preparation suggestions and alternatives will be distributed on Day 1.
- If you have any questions during the event, or if you need assistance with providing suitable meals for anybody in your OneCamp Unit, please ask the Catering Team. You can contact the Catering Team by calling the Event Operations Centre, or visiting Food Distribution Point A between 10:00am and 6:00pm.

# Food distribution points (FDPs)

- Bring a trek cart to transport your supplies from the FDP to your campsite.
  - 1 trek cart for 25 people (e.g. Unit with 75 people – 3 trek carts)
- Each food collection will provide for dinner, supper, breakfast, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea for the next 24-hour period.
- First collection is Tuesday 11 April. Last collection is Tuesday 18 April.

# FIRST FOOD COLLECTION

- On Tuesday 11 April there will be an additional food collection, available as soon as you arrive onsite.
- Collection will be:
  - Lunch and afternoon tea
  - Initial issue
  - Ice.
- Village 1, 2, 3, 4 can collect at any time from FDP A.
- Village 5 can call the EOC when ready and food will be delivered direct to your site.
- Daily collections commence in the afternoon on Tuesday 11 April.

# INITIAL ISSUE

- Each Unit will be provided with an initial issue pack, available for collection with their first food collection on Tuesday 11 April 2023.
- Units will be able to replenish their stock of initial issue items at FDP A between 10:00am and 6:00pm daily.

# ICE & GAS

- Ice will be available at food collection times each day from both FDPs.
- Swap 'n' Go gas bottles will be available for exchange at FDP A for Village 1, 2, 3, 4 Units at food collection times
- Swap 'n' Go gas bottles will be available for exchange for Village 5 Units by calling the EOC. Gas bottles will be delivered direct to your site.

- Modified diets will be provided as per the dietary information provided in the online event system.
- All meals will have alternatives for gluten, dairy, nut and egg free, and vegetarian.
- Line Leaders will be able to access dietary information in the online event system.
- We will not be able to provide specific brands. Parents/guardians who request specific brands could be encouraged to send those food items with their youth participant.



# STAFF KITCHEN

- The Staff Kitchen will service all volunteers not allocated to a OneCamp Unit.
- The Staff Kitchen will be open from 6:00am till 9:00pm daily, with biscuits, fruit and muesli bars as well as tea and coffee available during those times. Drop by to take some time out!
- If you are going to be late for mealtimes, get a message to the kitchen and we will ensure some food is put aside for you. **DO NOT GO HUNGRY!**
- A lunch station will be set up for those who will be offsite for the day, or who might be in the more remote areas of the site for the day.
