


#### COMMUNICATIONS

- Our **Event Operations Centre** (EOC) located in the **Hub** is your one-stop-shop if you need assistance with any matter.
- Drop in between 8:00am and 10:00pm, or call the phone number on your ID card at any time.
- The phone number will be operational 24/7, with a duty officer responding to afterhours calls for urgent support.
- We are not operating a radio system for OneCamp Units assistance is available by calling the EOC.
  - Adults will need their mobile phone (charging facilities available at the Hub).
- We will use text messaging as needed to broadcast key messages to adults at the event.
- Parents/caregivers can also call the EOC should they have questions.
- The EOC number will be published closer to the event.


### CHILD SAFE SCOUTING

- Everyone in Scouts, youth and adults alike, has the right to feel safe and be protected from abuse. No-one is allowed to threaten or hurt a youth or adult member or touch you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable, unsafe or afraid.
- A Scout is respectful, and this applies to all interactions between all participants, youth and adult, at OneCamp 2023.
- Not more than 3 weeks before OneCamp 2023, Group Leaders must ensure that Youth are reminded of their right to feel safe and that they should report any unacceptable behaviour to an Adult, which will be received without recrimination.
- If a youth member or adult member discloses abuse to you or you become aware of abuse, YOU MUST report it immediately to the Event Operations Centre by calling the number on your ID card.
- We will provide a further video briefing for all Leaders and adults to watch before OneCamp 2023.
