How to apply

Official applications OneCamp 2026 are not yet open. Be the first to know when application launch by submitting an obligation free EOI on our website at: www.onecamp.com.au.

Applications will open in mid-2025 and close on 30 November 2025. For your application to be considered complete, the first payment as per the payment schedule must be paid via our Online Event Application System before applications close.

Waiver forms

Some activities may require participants to have a completed waiver form signed by their parent or guardian. Should a participant (or their parent/guardian) choose not to complete the activity, a substitute activity will be arranged. No refunds will be provided.





Event fees

The different fees for each age section are detailed below. Event fees for Scouts, Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts have been spread across two payments.

^{*}Expedition costs for Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts are additional and depend on the expedition chosen. Expeditions are optional – Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts can attend the core event without attending an expedition if they choose. The payment schedule for expeditions will be advised once expeditions are announced later in 2025. All event fees can be paid online by credit card using our Online Event Application System. You can access the system via our website: www.onecamp.com.au.

Fee inclusions

The event fee includes:

- event program, including all activities and evening entertainment
- all accommodation costs
- transport to and from offsite activities
- transport to and from the event, including travel to and from Swan Valley for regional participants
- all meals for the duration of OneCamp 2026
- a merchandise pack including a polo shirt and a badge.

Expeditions for Venturer Scouts and Rover Scouts will attract an additional fee, determined by the expedition chosen by the participant.

Medical and dietary information

It is imperative that participant's personal, medical, and dietary information is currently recorded and updated as necessary in the Online Event Application System.
