Modified Diets Lead OneCamp 2026

Voluntary Position

The Purpose of the Scout Movement is to contribute to the education of young people in achieving their full physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual potentials as individuals, as responsible citizens and as members of their local, national and international communities.

Scouting focuses on youth members fully engaging with the program by supporting and managing those in adult and youth leadership roles.

OneCamp 2026 is the next iteration of our successful all-sections camp that will provide a unique major event experience for youth participants across all sections from Joey Scouts to Rover Scouts.

Role objective	Responsible for ensuring appropriate catering is provided to all event participants who have modified diets.
Role overview	As a key member of the Catering Team, you will liaise with participants and adult leaders to ensure appropriate catering for modified diets. The focus of this position is on ensuring Line Leaders in OneCamp Units receive appropriate provisions and support to cater for people with modified diets. You will work collaboratively across the Catering Team to ensure the smooth running of catering operations at the event, with a specific focus on modified diets. This role is available to a young adult or experienced supporting adult. This role is also
	required to undergo a probationary period of 6 months to assess suitability to the position.
Specific responsibilities	 Review information in the online event management system to plan for modified diets. Use the digital platform Catering Admin Kept Easy (CAKE) for end-to-end delivery of catering at OneCamp 2026. Work with the Catering Director to arrange procurement of food supplies to meet modified diet requirements for OneCamp Units. Oversee the daily packing of modified diet catering provisions for OneCamp Units. Work with OneCamp Unit line leaders to ensure suitable provisions for participants with modified diets are provided. Provide support and advice to line leaders to ensure all participants with modified diets are suitably catered for. Produce documents to communicate catering plans for participants with modified diets to OneCamp Units.
